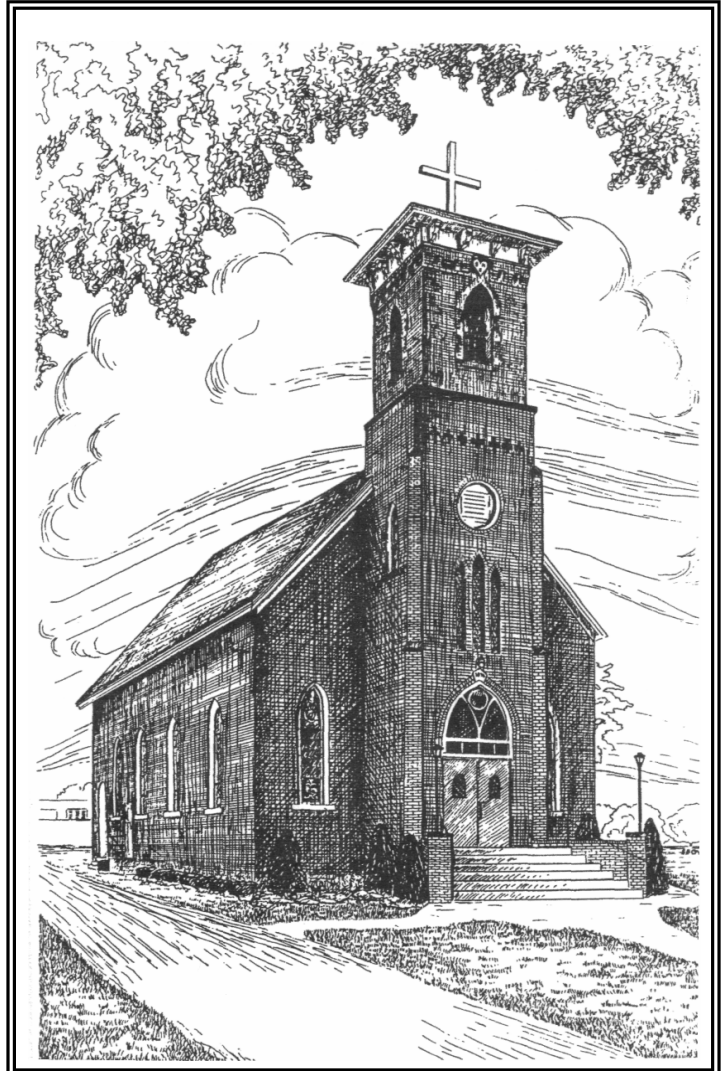

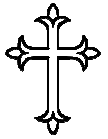

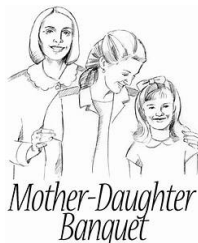


**Bishop’s Appeal 2018**
