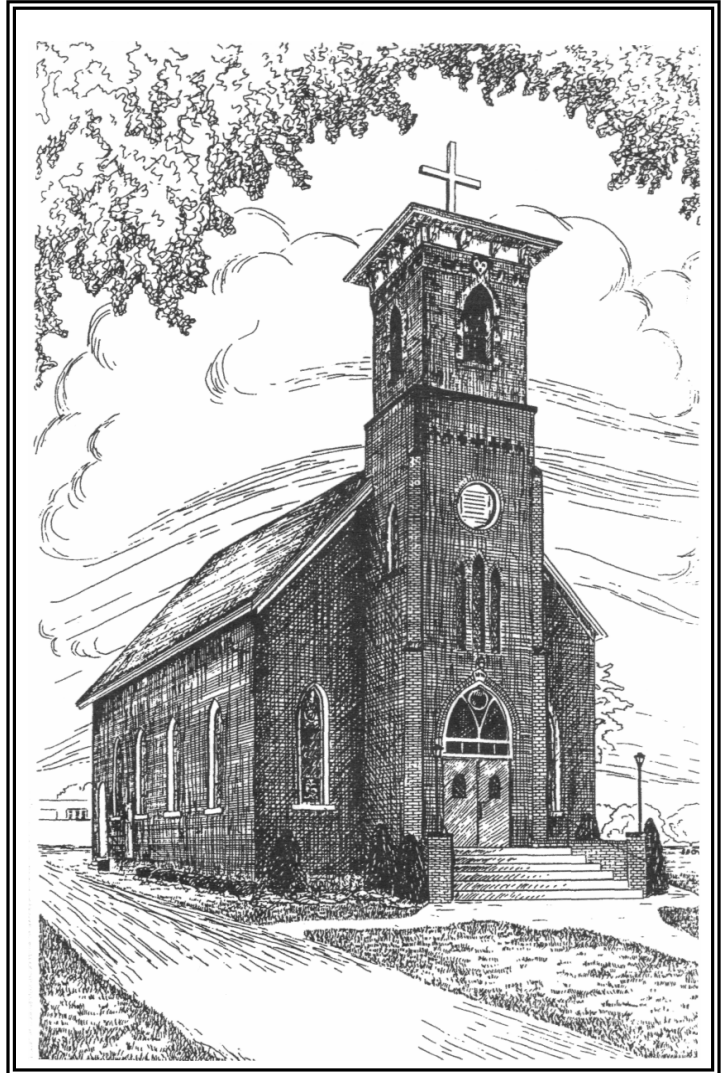

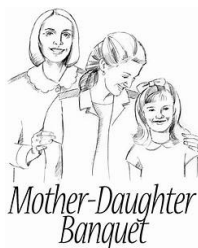


Bishop’s Appeal 2018
